

GROWTH STATUS RANKINGS | 2009 TO 2011 | BY MS SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH ACCOUNTABILITY STATUS RANKINGS 2011 - 2012 SCHOOL YEAR

WHAT THIS MAP SHOWS:

This map shows the MS School District Growth Status rankings for the last 3 years. This map also shows the new MS Dept. of Education Accountability Status rankings for each school district released Sept. 16, 2011.

The **BLACK** text in the map identifies the name of the district.
The **RED** text identifies the abbreviation for the ranking.
The **BLUE** text identifies the district's 2011 Growth Status.
The **GREEN** text identifies the district's 2010 Growth Status.
The **DARK RED** text identifies the district's 2009 Growth Status.

Growth Status Rankings are either Met or Not Met.

The performance rankings are divided into 6 categories. Below are the number of districts in each category and the percentage of the total 152 districts and the abbreviation in the map in red:

STAR = ST:
(4 Districts = 2.6%)

HIGH PERFORMING = HP:
(28 Districts = 18.4%)

SUCCESSFUL = S:
(50 Districts = 32.9%)

ACADEMIC WATCH = AW:
(43 Districts = 28.3%)

LOW PERFORMING = LP:
(25 Districts = 16.4%)

FAILING = F:
(2 Districts = 1.3%)

Total school districts in the dataset, including the Agricultural High Schools: 152

70 districts -46.1%- are ranked **LESS THAN Successful**.

Agricultural High Schools:

The Agricultural High Schools are not included in the visual map because they do not have discrete physical jurisdictions that school districts have.
