

QDI SCORES FOR 3 YEARS | 2009 to 2011 | WITH ACCOUNTABILITY STATUS RANKINGS BY MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR 2011 - 2012 SCHOOL YEARS

WHAT THIS MAP SHOWS:

This map shows the QDI scores for the the last 3 years. This map also shows the new MS Dept. of Education Accountability Status ratings for each school district that were released Sept. 16, 2011.

The BLACK text in the map identifies the name of the district.

The RED text identifies the abbreviation for 2011 accountability ranking

The BLUE text identifies the district's 2011 QDI score.

The GREEN text identifies the district's 2010 QDI score.

The DARK RED text identifies the district's 2009 QDI score.

The data indicate that 111 School Districts' QDI scores went up between the first and third years of the program, 15 School Districts were the same, and 26 School Districts QDI scores went down.

The performance rankings are divided into 6 categories. Below are the number of districts in each category, the percentage of districts in each category, and the abbreviation for each category shown in the map in red:

STAR = ST:
(4 Districts = 2.6%)

HIGH PERFORMING = HP:
(28 Districts = 18.4%)

SUCCESSFUL = S:
(50 Districts = 32.9%)

ACADEMIC WATCH = AW:
(43 Districts = 28.3%)

LOW PERFORMING = LP:
(25 Districts = 16.4%)

FAILING = F:
(2 Districts = 1.3%)

Total school districts in the dataset, including the Agricultural High Schools: 152

70 districts – 46.1% – are ranked LESS THAN Successful.

Agricultural High Schools:
The Agricultural High Schools are not included in the visual map because they do not have discrete physical jurisdictions that school districts have.
