

# Mississippi Adequate Education Program Underfunded in Fiscal Years 2011 - 2013

This map shows the amount of underfunding of the Mississippi Adequate Education Program for each public school district during fiscal years 2011, 2012, and 2013.

"Fiscal year" refers to the budget year from July 1 through June 30 of the following year. For example, fiscal year 2013 begins July 1, 2012 and ends June 30, 2013.

Each district is color coded by the amount of funds the district was underfunded for fiscal year 2013 based on the MAEP formula.

The name of each district is labeled in BLACK.

The Amount of underfunding in fiscal year 2013 is labeled in RED.

The Amount of underfunding in fiscal year 2012 is labeled in BLUE.

The Amount of underfunding in fiscal year 2011 is labeled in GREEN.

The data for this map was derived from data provided by the MS Dept. of Education and from data and calculations graciously provided by the The Parents' Campaign, Jackson, MS.

There are 152 Mississippi school districts. Three of those districts are Agricultural High Schools which do not have a visual location on the map.
