

Mississippi Adequate Education Program Underfunded in Fiscal Year 2013 with 2011-2012 Accountability Status Rankings

This map shows the amount of underfunding of the Mississippi Adequate Education Program for each public school district during fiscal year 2013.

"Fiscal year 2013" refers to the budget year from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. Fiscal years are defined by the end date of the year involved.

Each district is color coded by the 2011-2012 Accountability Status Ranking for that district.

The name of each district is labeled in BLACK.

The Accountability Status Ranking is shown in RED.

The Amount of MAEP funding in fiscal year 2013 is labeled in BLUE.

The Amount of underfunding in fiscal year 2013 is labeled in GREEN.

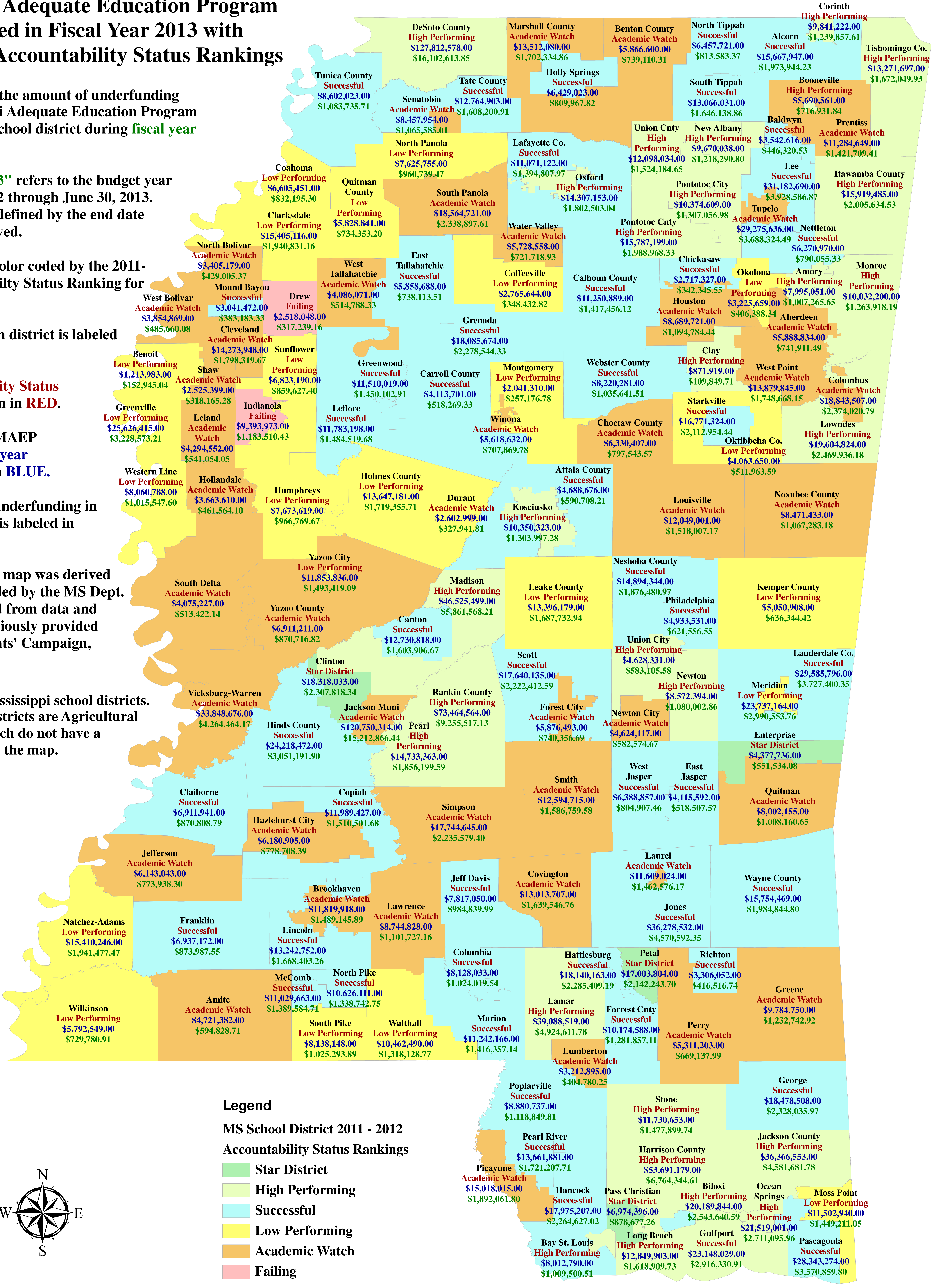
The data for this map was derived from data provided by the MS Dept. of Education and from data and calculations graciously provided by the The Parents' Campaign, Jackson, MS.
