

CRITICAL TEACHER SHORTAGES IN MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACT LOW WEALTH AND AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDENTS

LEGEND:

- SATP = SUBJECT AREA TESTING PROGRAM. SATP tests are given in high school. Passage of these tests is required to graduate.
- ACT = AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST. In Mississippi this is the most widely used college entrance examination.
- "College Core Students" refers to those students that have taken all of the state-mandated Core Curriculum courses.
- MEAN = Average of the data derived from all school districts reporting as individual units

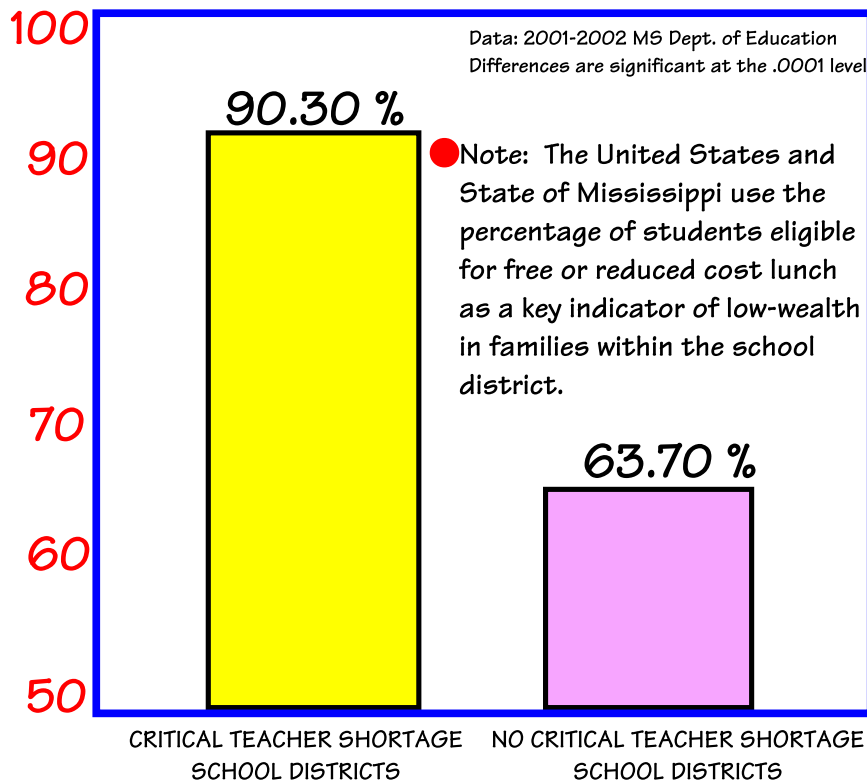
THIS DATA SHOWS THE DISPARITY BETWEEN
