
WHAT THIS MAP SHOWS:

This maps shows the new MS Dept. of Education **Accountability ratings for each school district** as to whether GROWTH GOALS were met released Sept. 10, 2010.

The Accountability Status rankings are based on 3 primary factors:

- **1. Quality Distribution Index (QDI) cut scores;**
- 2. Whether Growth goals have been met; and
- **3. Graduation and School Completion rates.**

The new standards and benchmarks are



being phased in over a 4-year period. This means that the benchmarks and standards will be raised each year until Mississippi ratings are aligned with the ratings of schools across the nation.

The ratings for Growth Goals are divided into 2 categories:

1. Growth Goals MET; 2. Growth Goals NOT MET.


84 Districts: Growth Goals MET. 65 Districts: Growth Goals NOT MET.
