## HOW TO IDENTIFY A CENSUS TAKER



**TIME OF DAY**  
Census takers will visit between 9AM - 9PM LOCAL TIME

**VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION**  
An "Official Business" notice will be placed on the vehicle

**WEAR A MASK**  
Census takers are required to wear a mask and maintain 6ft social distancing

**ID BADGE**  
Ask for official Census Bureau identification


**SMART DEVICE**  
Census takers will carry an iPhone to record information

## How to verify a census worker's identity:



**Valid ID Badge**  
name and photograph  
U.S. Dept of Commerce  
watermark  
expiration date

**Will wear masks**  
and practice social distancing.  
They will not enter your home.
